



List of Devices that are Allowed/Not Allowed on Snowshoe Mountain's Slopes, Trails, and Lifts DEVICES ALLOWED NOT ALLOW D This list is subject to change at any time Revised 12/06/15

- From the West Virginian Ski Safety Act: Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
- From the Your Responsibility Code: Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Devices on the mountain must have metal edges.
- NO motorized, electric assist or powered devices allowed.
- Cross Country skiing and winter biking are allowed in the backcountry trail system. The backcountry trail system is not patrolled in the Winter and leads into remote areas. Please take necessary precautions and use at your own risk. Be alert for snowmobiles and other motorized vehicles.


