Please be aware that most devices require the use of a helmet while operating such devices on Snowshoe property. Snowshoe may deny some devices from accessing the lift system. Child backpacks must be removed from the back to access the lift. Children who are unable to walk on their own must be in a carrier or harness device in order to ride the lift with a parent or guardian.
